

This book was loaned to me by Norma Corella, one of our newer members. She has great ideas and energy and has jumped in feet first to motivate, inspire and recharge us. Thanks for this, Norma.

Multipliers by Liz Wiseman with Greg McKeown

When we try to lead and teach others to lead, whether in the political arena or the business world, we always note what works and what doesn't seem to work well to charge up or inspire that employee. But do we always figure out why they struggle? The major thesis of this business skill / self improvement book is to optimize your productivity by checking what style of management you are using. If you want to be a Dominator then your people will do exactly what they think you expect, taking no risks in bringing forward fresh and new ideas. If you try to be a Multiplier, you will leverage not only your management skills, but actually allow and facilitate an atmosphere where other "coming up the ladder" leaders will add to any project.

One of the risks of facilitating your people to duplicate and fine tune their idea and management skills is that these staffers will MOVE ON. The book encourages this type of movement, stating that anything less would be stagnation of hierarchy and ideas. In fact, the standard business organization chart is somewhat frowned upon as a dampener to ideas.

This book gave ideas how to continue to check yourself, as the leader, and encourages and inspires you to continue, even when there are bumps in the road.

I think in volunteer organizations like ours there is a different dynamic in that we are all giving up our precious time to make incredible things happen in our community. It is much more difficult for us to give free reign to experiment when our time is so precious limited. I know that in my personal style I have started to allow others to know what the parameter guidelines are and that if they are up to the task - stand back and let them do it their way. It may not always be your vision but it does allow others to feel empowered and basically, bond with their club. The limitation sometimes happens when we place blame on shortcomings and people become scared to step left or right - out of the path always taken.

A great read and I would recommend this to those who want to multiply or replicate their skills.
